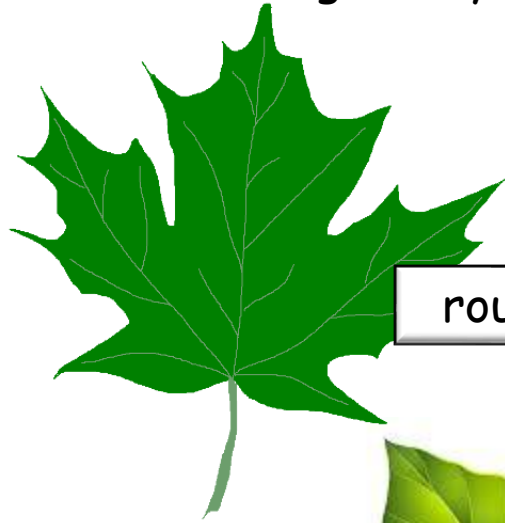
Leaves are different

single leaf



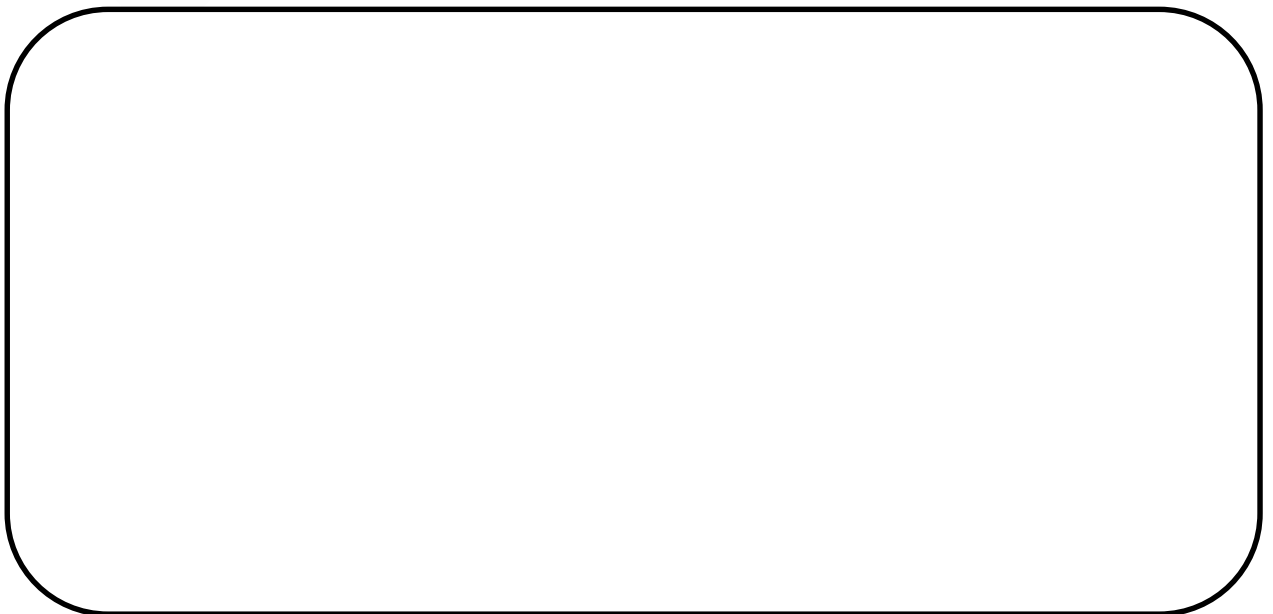
rough sides

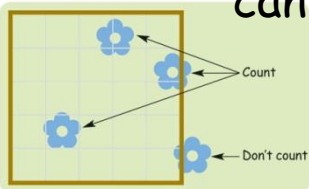
Barks have patterns!

Place the quadrant over an area. **Draw** what you can see. **Count** how many of each can you see **inside** the quadrant.

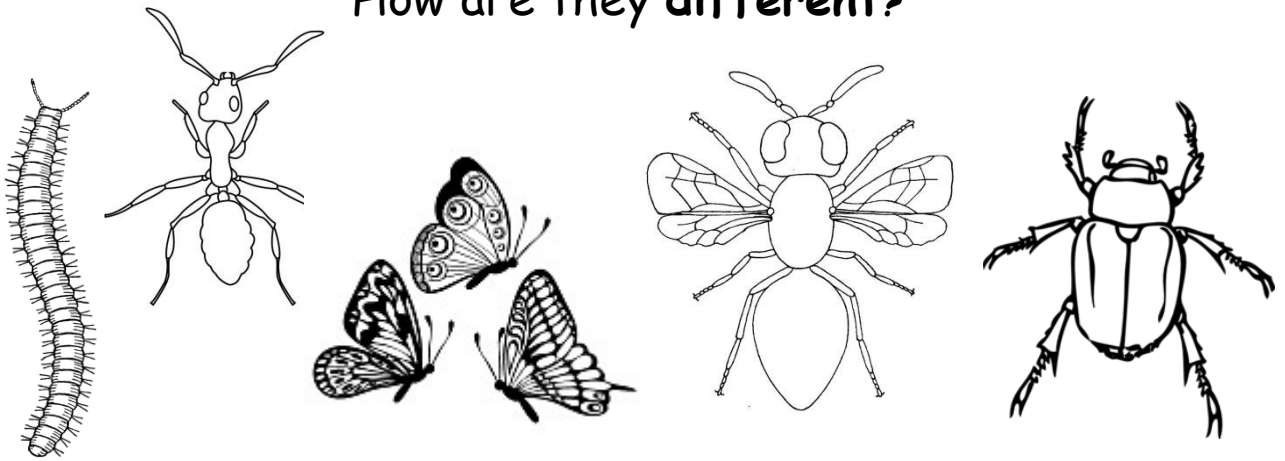


Insects around us
