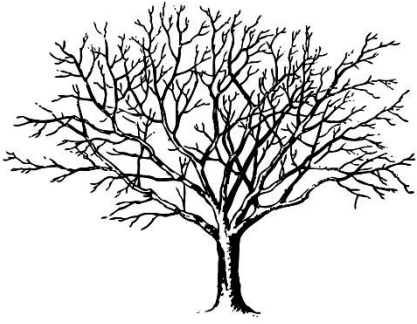
Using our senses



What do you see, hear, smell, taste and touch?
