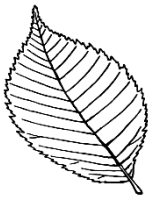

Food Chain

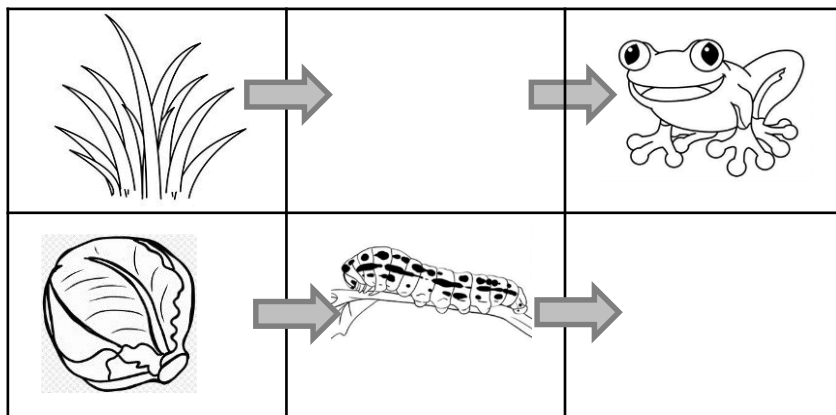
A food chain shows the path of energy from one living thing to another. Below is an example of a simple food chain found in the sea habitat.



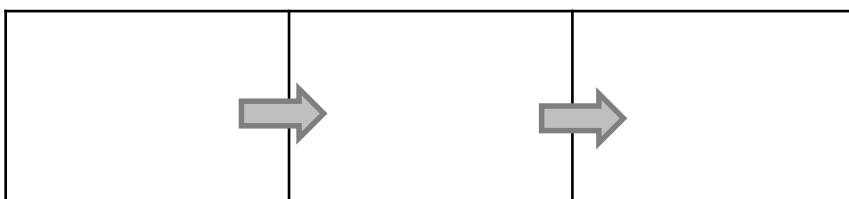
A. Write numbers (from 1 to 3) under each picture to show the correct order of the food chain below. The last number (4) has been done to help you.

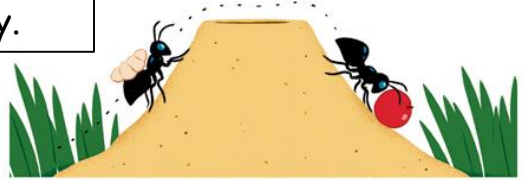

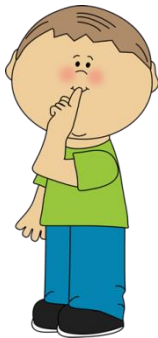

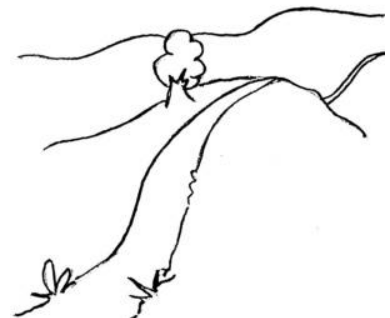
